Block level: Silver in boys Badminton doubles (Akash Pokhriyal and Mukul)

District level: Under 14 Gold in volleyball girls.

\* Under 14 Bronze in Volleyball boys.

\* Under 19 Bronze in Volleyball girls.

\* Under 10 Bronze in Kabaddi boys.

\* Under 14 Silver in Kabaddi girls.

International Olympiads are conducted in over 30,000 schools worldwide with over a million children participating in each of the different subjects.

In the International English Olympiad (IEO), 20 students gained an International rank within the first 500. In the G.K. Olympiad (IGKO), 19 students gained an International rank within the first 500. 6 students of class 1 ranked 23 in IEO and 2 students ranked 6 in IGKO.
